We also have cutting rights to over 33,000 hectares of plantation forests, at five forest locations in Hawke's Bay.</p> <p>In 2007, Pan Pac became wholly owned by Oji Green Resources, a fully owned subsidiary of Oji Holdings Limited.</p> <p><b>Pan Pac Forest Products (Otago) : lumber</b>                      In December 2014 we established a subsidiary company, Pan Pac Forest Products (Otago) Limited, a lumber business which operates a modern sawmill, boiler, continuous kiln and drymill from a site at Milburn just south of Dunedin in the South Island.</p>
